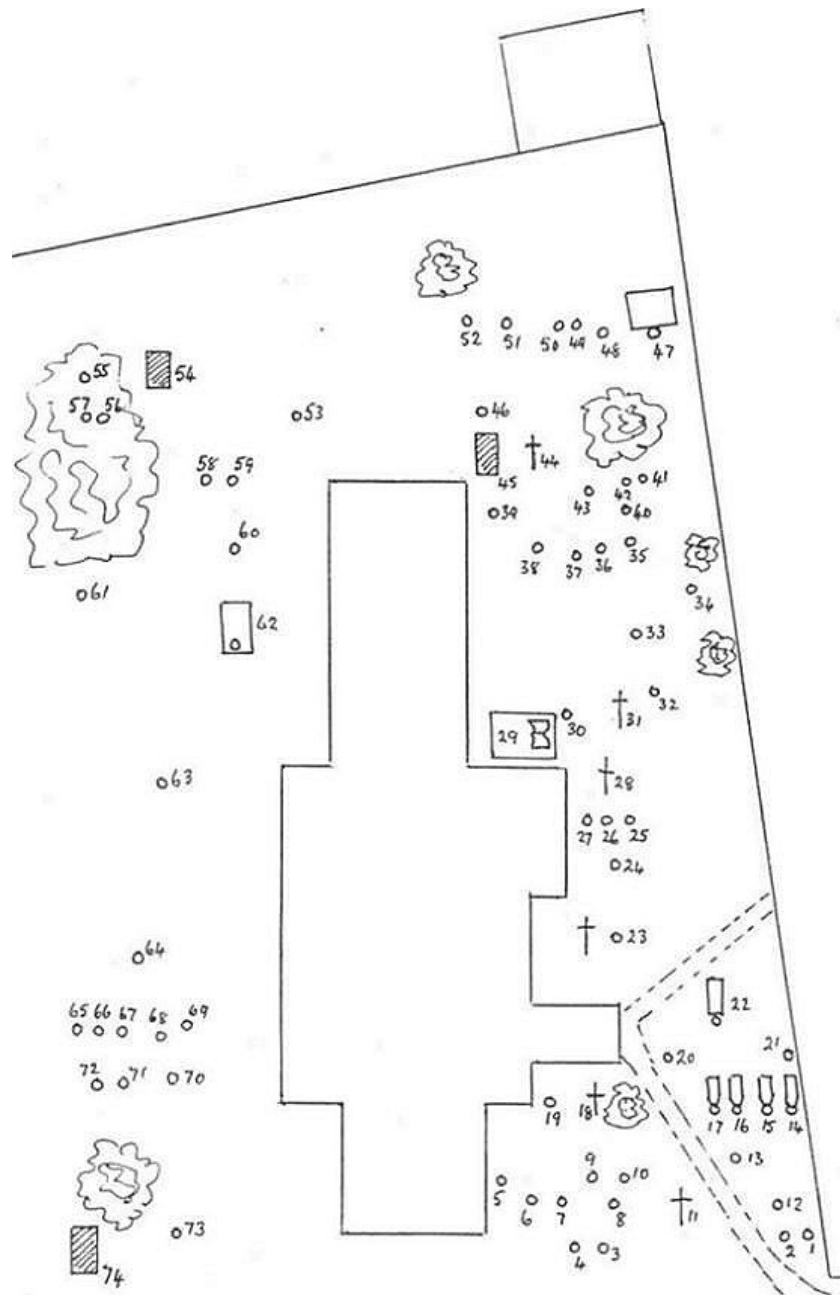


Parish Church of St Peter & St Paul, Bassingbourn

Black stone with white relief coat of arms and a figure. The figure is a youngish man with long curly dark hair, draped in cloth:

*This small monument is presented
To the memory of her dear and Vertuous Brother
Mr Henry Butler, who died the 2 of September 1647.
By the Lady Dingley, his most affectionate sister.
Who prayeth "This stone may lye until he rife,
to fee his Saviour with his eies."*
